## **Parents Transport children to events**

- It is the parent's responsibility to sign in any children they are dropping off before they leave the venue.

## **Photography (Only Staff & Partnership)**

- Parents will not be allowed to take Photos at any of the events.
- School Staff are welcome to take Photos of their own students.
- The Partnership will ask schools on arrival if they pupils have permission to be photographed and shared on social media.
- If a school arrives and the members of staff are unaware or have not been informed, then no Photos will be taken of any child within that team. If the teacher later confirms from the school any updated information, the event

manager will then allow photos to be taken of this team or child following the registration procedures.
